

Restore Hope and its partners such as Love One Another, Hillman House, Orphan Caregivers Association, and 25Project provide assistance to some of the most vulnerable youth in its project locations including orphans, street children, and children affected by disasters. Strength and vitality are luxuries when you are simply struggling to survive. The communities we work with are vulnerable to tropical diseases, lack awareness of good nutrition and hygiene practices and lack access to basic healthcare. As a result, they are hamstrung by dramatic HEALTH losses in school attendance. workforce productivity, and life itself. Restore Hope's investments in community health education, training of medical professionals, basic healthcare provision, and now plans for the construction of the West Africa Medical Center (WAMC), a first-class medical center in partnership with the West Africa Fistula Foundation which will open by providing life-changing fistula repair surgeries and training new medical professionals. DENTAL TREATMENT

Dental care is dramatically lacking in Sierra Leone. The dental clinic at the Hope Center is staffed with just the eighth dentist in the country and two nurse practitioners.



DENTAL CARE KIT

Many families do not have basic dental care supplies such as toothbrushes and toothpaste that can help prevent gum disease and tooth decay.













MEDICINE

Whether for dental procedures or tropical diseases, these medicines can have a dramatic impact on the health and survival of our patients, especially children and the elderly.



NEW DRESS FOR WAMC PATIENTS

The women treated at WAMC literally have a new lease on life as they can now be welcomed back into their communities and families. Help us send them home with a beautiful new dress to accompany their beaming smiles!



1 WEEK ROOM & BOARD FOR WAMC PATIENT

WAMC patients stay an average of 3-4 months as they prepare for and recover from their surgeries.

They receive encouragement and educational instruction during their_stay.



DOCTOR, NURSE AND MIDWIFE TRAINING

WAMC will address an alarming lack of trained medical professionals including doctors, nurses and midwives to help reduce the world's worst maternal and infant mortality rates. Your gift will support this training and residency program.



1 COMMUNITY HEALTH EDUCATION BINDER

These binders will be used to train community health educators who will teach good hygiene and nutrition to reduce the incidence of disease and malnutrition. A total of five binders are needed.

DOCTOR & NURSE PRACTITIONER RESIDENCY

WAMC will initially rely upon a cadre of rotating OB/GYN doctors and nurse practitioners to volunteer their services for anywhere from a couple of weeks to a few months at a time. Your gift will help fund their expenses for this vital service.



GYNECOLOGICAL SURGERY at WAMC

The first phase of the West Africa Medical Center will provide fistula repair and gynecological surgeries that will create new opportunities for women and help reduce the world's worst maternal mortality rate.

Due to poor housing conditions, some of the widows of Grafton near the Hope Center are still vulnerable to inclement weather and disease. Your gift can literally put a roof over a family's head.

Water filtration systems can provide clean water for an entire community of 10,000 or a single household. Help save thousands of lives by investing in these systems large and small.



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

The needs of many communities are wide-ranging including infrastructure development, public safety, crisis response and management, civic engagement, healthy institutions, waste management, and more. Restore

Hope takes a holistic approach with its partner communities helping them to identify their challenges, resources and

opportunities while connecting them with the resources and partners they need to realize their dreams. By building the capacity of local stakeholders to meet their needs, we are making an investment in the restoration of hope and opportunity among our partner communities.

Diarrhea, primarily caused by contaminated water sources, kills more children per year than malaria, AIDS and measles combined. (WHO) Only 50% of the population in Niger has access to a protected water source. (World Bank)

A community's ability to support life and prosper often hinges on the use of its human and natural resources. A family's income can determine whether or not children go to school, the sick get well, or a meal is cooked on any given day. You may know the proverb about teaching a man to fish, but what if he doesn't have a fishing pole or nobody in his village has one? Whether through skills development, value chain development, or start-up capital, Restore Hope invests in helping workers, small farmers and business owners get the resources they need to grow their local economies.

75% of the people living in extreme poverty (equivalent to \$1.25 or less per day) live in sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia.





MORINGA SEEDS AND SEEDLINGS

Moringa seeds and seedlings can help begin a farming cooperative that will produce nutritious, life-saving plants and generate income for poor rural communities.





MORINGA FARMER KITS

Farming tools are needed to supply the farming co-ops with the basic resources to begin operating their moringa farms.

FOUR GOATS

Goats are a valuable source of meat and milk in Africa. Your gift of a handful of goats (three female, one male) can help a partner farmer generate income and feed his family.





The moringa tree grows in tropical regions of the world and its leaves contain 7x vitamin C of an orange, 4x vitamin A of carrots, 4x calcium of milk, 3x potassium of bananas, 2x protein of yogurt. Common uses of moringa include tea, powder supplements, fertilizer, and water purification.

Every good organization needs good leadership and the resources to put its plans into action. We at Restore Hope are dreaming big because we are driven by the struggles faced by entire communities and the

individuals and families are comprised.
